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The summit will host 2 in depth panel discussions with prestigious leaders in education from across Canada. The day 1 panel presentation is focused around the theme The Past is Prologue exploring eliminating barriers and accelerating what matters for K to 12 learners. Nurturing networks driven by impact, efficacy and evidence. Redesigning partnerships and processes that leverage emerging technology. The day 2 panel discussion will focus on public education and technology in 2023, a national conversation, C21 Canada board and CIO alliance collaboration.
